

We believe that you, the parent or guardian, are our partners guiding your child on an exhilarating journey to educational success.


Your interaction with your child is the cornerstone of parent involvement. We welcome parental input and strive to provide an exciting and rich learning experience that will be the basis for your child's future success.



Preschool through First Grade



The Northbridge Elementary students, parents, faculty, staff and administration comprise a diverse, creative and caring community. The Northbridge Elementary staff works hard to promote a life-long love of learning in their students.



Mathematics

Our students are taught that mathematical ideas exist in the world around them and that opportunities to express oneself mathematically are plentiful. Children are provided with at least 70 minutes of math instruction daily. Our students also receive mathematical instruction using a hands-on approach with manipulatives. Our math curriculum for children in preschool through grade one are standards based with an emphasis on hands on learning and real world applications.

English Language Arts

Reading and writing play an important part in our curriculum. Students in grade one are exposed to a 90 minute uninterrupted block of language arts every day. Our preschool, kindergarten and first grade students thrive in a language-based environment that is rich with print.

Science & Social Studies

Science and Social Studies are taught in isolation as well as integrated within the curriculum. Students are exposed to theme based instruction and hands on activities.
